

The project activities that must be executed sometimes hinge on decisions that are made due to project conditions or performance. This webinar will show you how "what if" analysis can be used to plan and forecast project performance in situations where the course of the project is uncertain or decisions will be made during the course of a project.

Tip of the Day - Using your results in Excel

There are times when you may need to move the results of your analysis to Excel or another spreadsheet application to take advantage of inhouse reports or to present your data in another chart or graph. Luckily, getting the data out of the application is easy.

- 1. To move data from any of RiskyProject histograms, cumulative probability, or scatterplots, simply right-click on the chart and choose **Copy Data to Clipboard**. Open Excel and paste the data in your worksheet.
- 2. If you require more extensive data, this can be captured copied from the <u>Simulations</u> Results report. We recommend modifying the report to show the columns with the data you would like to move to Excel. In Excel, create a worksheet that has the same column titles in the same order as found in the Simulations Results such that it clearly identifies exactly what data is in the column. In the Simulations Results report, select the task information that you want to move to Excel, right click and choose **Copy Tasks**. In Excel, simply paste the data into your worksheet.
