
Book Launch: ProjectThink



Tip of the Day - Assigning threats and opportunities qualitatively

Due to the substantive differences between a quantitative and qualitative risk analysis, the risk register has a different behavior when assigning risks to your project. This is especially evident in how the system handles threats and opportunities. When you perform quantitative risk analysis, RiskyProject determines whether a risk is a threat or an opportunity based on outcome of the risks: negative outcome means opportunity. During qualitative analysis, risks can be flagged by the user as either a threat, opportunity or both. In the example below, you can see that it is possible to assess the same risk as both a threat and an opportunity.

To set a risk as an opportunity or threat:

- 1. After you have added a risk to the risk register, click the **Probabilities and Outcomes** tab.
- 2. Enter **Chance** which will be used to calculate probability.
- 3. Select **Outcome Type** from drop down list.
- 4. Assign the risk as a Threat or an Opportunity using the Threat/Opportunity drop-down list. When this selection is made the outcomes available will now reflect that the risk assignment is a threat or opportunity.
- 5. Select an outcome from the Outcome drop-down list.
- 6. Click OK to save the assignments.
